




Wester Ross Scenic Photo Project: How to find the locations and take the photos




Thank you for taking part in Scottish Natural Heritage's pilot photography project.

Scenic Viewpoint 1 Glen Docherty			<p>Car park at the Glen Docherty viewpoint signposter from the A832. Stand at the information board and take the photograph facing west towards Loch Maree. This is one of the gateways to Wester Ross National Scenic Area and is one of the first sights many visitors will have of the area.</p>	206554.4 859450.6	57.58353 -5.2375	NH06555945
Scenic Viewpoint 2 Upper car park at Slattadale			<p>Roadside layby on the A832 at Slattadale. This view of Loch Maree, with woodland in front, is taken from the centre of the wooded edge of the parking looking roughly eastwards. This is a mix of natural woodland which has been growing since the plantation was felled. Scenic Viewpoint 3 Slattadale Forestry Commission car park and picnic area loch side car park			<p>View of Victoria Falls from Slattadale loch side car park and picnic area, on east (loch) side of A832 at Slattadale.</p> <p>This photo is taken facing South-East, from the centre of the 4 picnic tables</p> <p>This view is likely to change as a hydroelectric scheme is installed and the access track that you can see on the slopes is restored to the land's original condition.</p>	188854.9 872163.7	57.68958 -5.54405	NG88857216
Scenic Viewpoint 4 Coille na Glas-leitire Car park Beinn Eighe NNR			<p>Beinn Eighe NNR car park on the east (loch) side of the A832 at Coille na Glas-leitire.</p> <p>This photo was taken facing north east, behind the information board.</p> <p>There is new native woodland along the shores of Loch Maree so over the next few decades it could become a very different view. Scenic Viewpoint 5a Loch Torridon looking west			<p>Informal car park signed as a viewpoint, on the north (loch) side of the A896, at Upper Loch Torridon.</p> <p>The photo is taken from the western edge of the car park, looking west towards Loch Torridon and Loch Sheildaig.</p> <p>This view is likely to alter slowly with changes in vegetation.</p>	186571.3 854246.6	57.52788 -5.56649	NG86575424
Scenic Viewpoint 5b Loch Torridon looking east			<p>Informal car park signed as a viewpoint, on the north (loch) side of the A896, at Upper Loch Torridon.</p> <p>The photo is from the eastern edge of the car park, looking towards the village of Torridon. This is a crofting settlement with improved pasture in front of the houses and rougher grazing on the slopes behind.</p>	186571.3 854246.6	57.52788 -5.56649	NG86575424

Scenic Viewpoint 5c Loch Torridon looking north			Informal car park signed as a viewpoint, on the north (loch) side of the A896, at Upper Loch Torridon. The photo is taken looking north towards Beinn Alligin and Beinn Dearg: an impressive view of the Torridon mountains. New native woodland along the shore and lower slopes will gradually bring about some changes	186571.3 854246.6	57.52788 -5.56649	NG86575424
Scenic Viewpoint 6 Gairloch			Car park on the seaward side of the A832, at the viewpoint above the village of Gairloch. Gairloch is a bustling village that may experience change over the next few years.	180424.2 877421	57.73267 -5.68996	NG80427742

Please remember that these locations are all public parking areas so there may be vehicles moving around while you're there. You will need to be outside to take the photograph so be prepared for the weather, ground conditions and other outdoor hazards.
