INVENTORY - KINLOCH CASTLE, ISLE OF RUM

Thank you for your letter of 16th May regarding apparent discrepancies in the Inventory prepared by ██████████ of the contents of Kinloch Castle.

I have checked ██████████ notes and confirm that the Inventory should be amended in accordance with the physical check made during the hand-over except for item 209. As you suggest, the errors were in the typist's transcription from ██████████ notes.

1. Item 150. Only one water-colour drawing was recorded. ██████████ notes confused the typist.
2. Item 209. ██████████ notes show 25 plates 10 of which are in the luggage room.
3. Item 487. Typist's error, should be 26 swords.
4. Item 546. Method of recording is mis-leading, only one set of coal tongs should be shown.
5. Item 606. Only one bolster, mis-interpretation by typist.
6. Item 792. The entry should read "a pine bedroom chair".
7. Item 918. This item is 2 electric kettles.
8. Item 980. ██████████ noted two large oval dish-covers, i.e. two covers.
